*Call to Worship: from Luke 24:34 & I Peter 1:3-5

Leader: Alleluia, Christ is risen!

Congregation: He is risen indeed, Alleluia!

Leader: Blessed be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you. Alleluia, Christ is risen!

Congregation: He is risen indeed, Alleluia!

*The Hymn: "Christ the Lord Is Risen Today" (vv.1-3) No. 217 *Responsive Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:12-20, 55-57

Leader: Now if Christ is proclaimed as raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain. We are even found to be misrepresenting God, because we testified about God that he raised Christ, whom he did not raise if it is true that the dead are not raised. For if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised.

And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. If in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied. But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep.

Congregation: Death is swallowed up in victory. O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?

Leader: The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. All: But thanks be to God, who gives us victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

*Profession of Faith: from the Westminster Larger Catechism, Question 52

Leader: How was Christ exalted in His resurrection?

All: We believe... "Christ rose again from the dead the third day by His own power; whereby He declared himself to be the Son of God, to have satisfied divine justice, to have vanguished death, and him that had the power of it, and to be Lord of the living and the dead: All of which He did as a public person, the *Head of the Church, for our justification, progress in grace, support against* enemies, and to assure us of our resurrection from the dead at the last day."
